(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow micro-surfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Heath Road, East Farleigh.

A closure is planned from 15th December 2020, between the hours of 22:00 and 05:00, with estimated completion by 16th December 2020. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

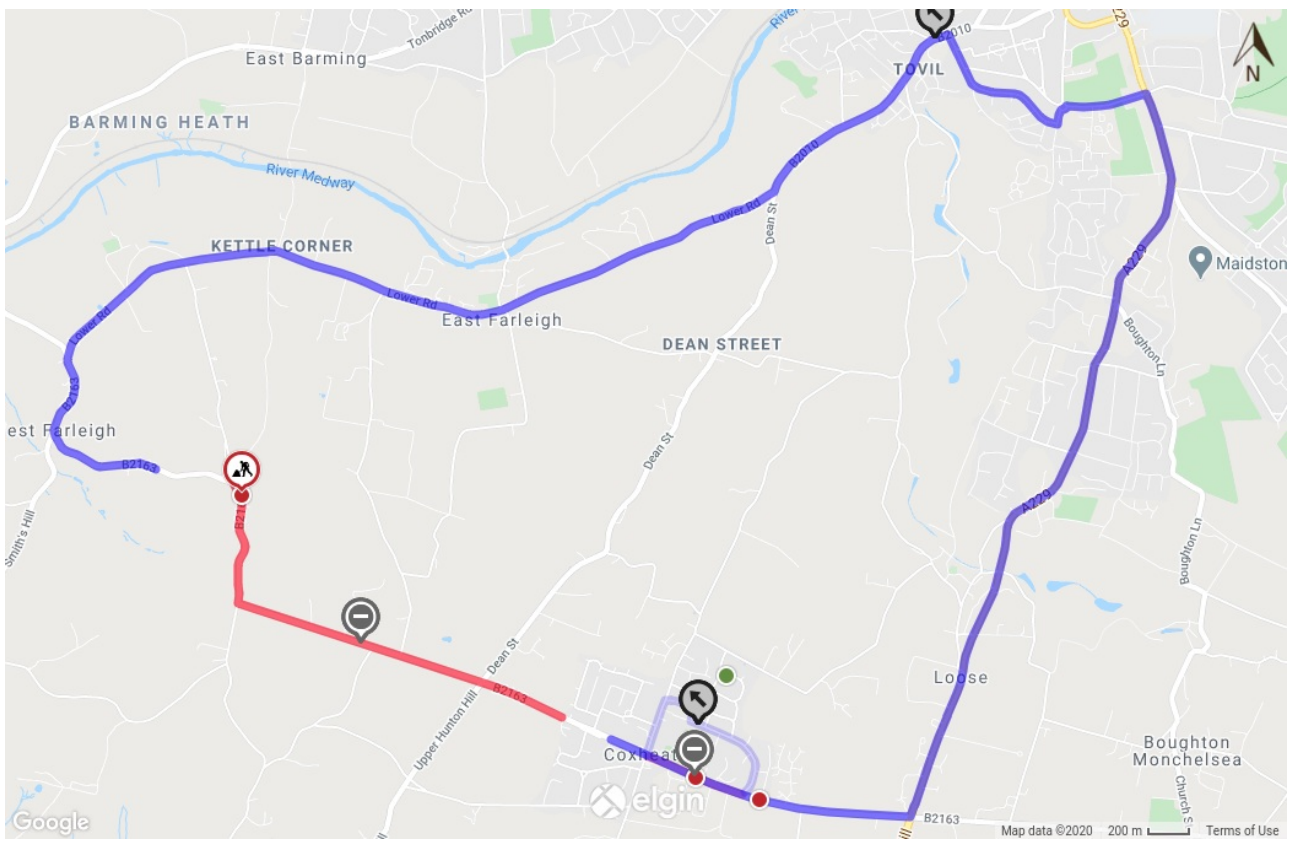
Heath Road will be closed from the junction with Ewell Lane to outside the vicinity of Yelton, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while micro-surfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2163 Heath Road, A229 Linton Road, Loose Road, Armstrong Road, Postley Road, Forest Hill, Courtenay Road, B2010 Tovil Road, Tovil Hill, Farleigh Hill, Dean Street, Lower Road, Ewell Lane and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
